Dr. Elizabeth Knapp Smith Ethics in Business	Provide scholarships to undergraduate students who are registered for one or more credit hours in courses in business ethics and who have demonstrated a commitment to serving the interests of their community. First priority for awarding such scholarships shall be given to students who demonstrate financial need.	<i>Proof of community service through FSU Serv Script, or letter from organization. Completed Federal Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA). Proof of ethics course.</i>
Marguerite Neel Williams Business Ethics	Provide scholarships to students with financial need, who have completed at least one or more credit hours in a course in business ethics, must be awarded to residents of Georgia (predominantly Southwest Georgia) or North Florida. The student must also demonstrate a commitment to serving their community.	<i>Proof of community service through FSU Serv Script, or letter from organization.
