CNL Group, Inc.	Scholarships for first and second year undergraduate students with less than 52 credit hours. Additional criteria include priority consideration for children of CNL employees or Orlando-area students.	<i>Proof of class level, employment, and county of residence.</i>
Hecht-Havenick-Amdur	To provide scholarships for graduate and undergraduate students attending FSU. Students may be selected from any academic discipline, but consideration should be given to the children of employees and relatives of the Naples-Fr. Myers Greyhound Track and Flagler Greyhound Track.	<i>Proof of employment from Naples-Fort Myers Greyhound Track or Flagler Greyhound Track.</i>
Jeanette and Cliff Davenport	Provide awards to public high school graduates who would like to attend Florida State University and who qualify within the following conditions: 1) The student is a graduate of a public high school within the region of Florida containing the counties of Citrus, Hernando, Lake, Levy, Marion, Putnam and Sumter. 2) The student has demonstrated a need for financial support to the extent that university attendance would not be possible from the resources available to the student either from his/her own resources or the resources of the family. 3) Student pursuing a Major in the areas of Management, Finance, Marketing, Public Relations or Communications.	<i>Proof of graduation from a high school from the following counties: Citrus, Hernando, Lake Levy, Marion, Putnam or Sumter. Russell H. Langstroth	To award scholarships to Community College transfer students with an AA degree from Broward, Dade, and Palm Beach counties. Students will be eligible for this scholarship if they meet the following criteria: 1. are a resident of Florida, living in Broward, Dade, Palm Beach or Monroe counties; 2. have a financial need; 3. are well rounded students who have demonstrated an involvement in sports, with a preference to those with an interest in tennis; 4. have volunteer experience and/or have participated in clubs, extracurricular activities or community programs; 5. have a minimum of 3.0 GPA; 6. have a goal or stated direction of what they want to accomplish at FSU. Selection of deserving eligible students shall be made by the Office of Financial Aid (OFA). Preference for selection shall be given to qualified applicants who are direct descendants of those former FSU male students enrolled during the 1946-47 academic year through the Tallahassee Branch - University of Florida (TBUF); such former students are identified in the Office of Alumni Affairs. Barring the application of an eligible TBUF descendant, the OFA may award this scholarship to any eligible applicant according to its office policies and priorities.	<i>Proof that you are a direct descendant of former FSU male students enrolled during the 1946-47 academic year through the Tallahassee Branch - University of Florida (TBUF), these students can be identified through Alumni Affairs.</i>
